Terms and Conditions

- ✓ Candidates are required to provide the correct 'UCI Number', and 'Entry Codes' required for entering each examination. Failure to do so may result in your final subject grade(s) being nullified and not qualifying for certification.
- ✓ If the Candidate does not turn up on the day of the exam, the student will be marked absent, and no refund will be offered.
- ✓ It is the responsibility of the candidate to collect their 'Statement of Entry' (Timetable)
 - Results/Certificate along with the JCQ 'Notice to Candidate' from the examination department beforehand.
- ✓ Results and certificates are to be collected in person by the candidate. The Centre will keep the certificate for up to 12 months from the date of issue. Unique Sixth Form has the legal duty to keep uncollected certificates for only one year.
- ✓ For the summer exam series, the examination timetable together with the confirmation of the statement of entrance shall be made available by the end of March, not earlier. Please visit our website if you're interested in viewing the exam timetable in any series; https://usfl.co.uk/exams-timetable/
- ✓ Exams Officers reserve the right to cancel the exam entry form under certain circumstances.
- ✓ Above mentioned fees are only exam fees, there is not include any other services such as practical's, coursework, resources, posting results/certificates, etc.
- ✓ Early Exams Entry Bird deadline is -29th December 2024 * Early Bird exam fees are applicable for select subjects; for further information, get in touch with the examinations officer.

Exams Cancellation Policy:

- Candidates have the right to cancel their exams under certain circumstances, but they need to cancel the exams before the cancellation deadline. The final cancellation deadline is beforehand the JCQ board amendment deadline. But CIE is before the 1st entry deadline, please ask the exams officer or find out the board website when the specific deadline is. After the 2nd deadline, there is no cancellation/removal of CIE entry.
- o If a candidate registers for any exams with very high late fees or double late fees, the candidate cannot cancel, or defer after registration.
- During the exam operations time or after sitting for the first or second paper, candidates cannot request the cancellation of their exam entry.
- o Exams entry cancellation deadline is 15th April each year.

Fees Refunds Policy:

- After submitting the exam entry form if the candidate wants to cancel entry before the entry deadline, a 10% admin fee will be levied from the refund.
- o If the entry has been registered with the exam board and the candidate then wishes to withdraw the exam entry before their amendment period has passed, a 75% refund is payable. A 25% deduction applies as an admin fee. There is no refund after the amendment period. After the amendment deadline, the candidate will not get any refund fees. For CIE (Cambridge) exam board there will be no refund after the 1st entry deadline.

Others' Policy:

- Candidate documents: Candidate's documents, such as ID images, passport copies, and video data are gathered for the submitting exam entry to the education board portal, exams sitting, conducting, and monitoring purposes only.
- Candidate images are being monitored and recorded for the purpose of preventing exam malpractice and candidate safety. Images may also be used as part of investigations into potential breaches of JCQ and CIE policies and practices, as well as grievances or misconduct of any claims.
- Candidates with a diagnosed medical condition (including mental health) dyslexia, learning, or physical disability must inform the exam officer upon negotiation. There will be fees applicable for the different services.

Open-Book exam:

- It is your responsibility to let the Exams Officer know at least 15 days before your exam that you will be requiring materials for an open-book exam. Unique Sixth Form will not take responsibility for providing you with open-book materials on the day of the exam unless you have given us sufficient notice.
- If you have two scheduled exams, you are entitled to a break with a maximum time of 15 minutes. However, you will be supervised during this break and are not allowed to leave the premises.
- If you are planning on eating or drinking during this time, please make sure that you have already purchased your food or drink.

Clashing exams:

 If you have any clashing exams, you must let the Exams Officer know before exams board late entry deadline.
